This comprehensive 16 hour program will take the experienced law enforcement rifle shooter from 50 yards out to 200 yards with the goal of improving their marksmanship. ERPR gives the officer the fundamentals and experience to utilize their patrol rifle to the full extent of the rifle's capabilities. The course covers traditional and improvised shooting positions, utilizing low powered optical sights commonly found on LE Patrol Rifles, determining the maximum effective range of you and your rifle, the effect of intermediate barriers on bullet performance and developing enhanced marksmanship ability with the patrol rifle at ranges beyond 50 yards. ERPR requires moderate physical conditioning and an accurate rifle with a low power (up to 5x) optical sight. The program will run rain or shine so be prepared for the weather. Successful completion of the certification requirements will yield certification as a DESIGNATED PATROL MARKSMAN. Previous attendees can recertify at this class.

Equipment Requirements:

Patrol rifle with sling and LOW power optic At least 3 magazines and 500 rounds of duty or quality FMJ ammo (NO STEEL CORE BULLETS!!!) Duty belt, Eye & Hearing protection, soft body armor Come prepared for two full days of practical training! We shoot rain, sleet, snow or sunshine.
