

MPTC PISTOL QUALIFICATION COURSE FOR MOBILE SHOOTING TRAILERS

Target to be used: Q-68 (Q target reduced to 67%). Available from Law Enforcement Targets (www.letargets.com)

3 Yards (6 FEET)

RUN TWO OFFICERS AT A TIME AT 3 YARD LINE

On Command, shooter will deploy the CQB tactic as the instructor demonstrated. Movement will be employed at this distance (left/right/rear). All rounds will count towards score at this distance.

5 Yards (10 FEET)

RUN ONE OFFICER AT A TIME AT 5 YARD LINE

Transition to Deadly Force	Fire Two Rounds
Transition to Deadly Force	Fire Two Rounds
Transition to Deadly Force	Fire Two Rounds
Transition to Deadly Force	Fire Two Rounds move to the left
Transition to Deadly Force	Fire Two Rounds move to the right

Transition can be from O/C, Baton, etc. Simulating that the current force level option has escalated to DEADLY FORCE. Shooter to make magazine changes as necessary. On command, shooter will transition to deadly force (firearm).

7 Yards (14 FEET)

RUN TWO OFFICERS AT A TIME AT 7 YARD LINE

Move from 15 Yard line (30 FEET) to the 7 Yard line (14 FEET) and fire Ten Rounds
On command, shooter will start from the 15 yard line and move forward with the weapon drawn up on target. At the 7 Yard line, they will fire. Magazine changes as necessary.

10 Yards (20 FEET)

RUN TWO OFFICERS AT A TIME AT 10 YARD LINE

Facing Left @ 15 Yards (30 FEET), turn & move to 10 Yard Line (20 FEET)
Fire Two Rounds

Facing Right @ 15 Yards, turn & move to 10 Yard Line Fire Three Rounds
Facing to the Rear @ 15 Yards, turn & move to 10 Yard Fire Five rounds
Shooters start at 15 Yard marker w/holstered weapon. On command, Shooters will
TURN and draw, then move to the 10 Yard line with weapon drawn up on target.
Shooter will fire when reaching the 10 Yard marker the prescribed amount of rounds.
PERFORM DRILL DRY FIRST!

15 Yards (30 FEET)

RUN TWO OFFICERS AT A TIME AT 15 YARD LINE

- Shooter to have two magazines with five rounds in each magazine
- Fire one magazine and perform a magazine change with communication
- Fire second magazine for a total of Ten Rounds.

Shooters will fire the first magazine of 5 rounds and perform a mag change, while communicating to their partner: Slide lock back: shooter shouts "COVER." Partner shouts "COVERING," Magazine is changed: Shooter shouts "READY." And partner shouts "OKAY."
